Scope

Submission of Papers

For the research track, submissions should describe original research work. For the industrial and administration track, submissions should describe innovative products or good practices. Submissions will be judged for scientific quality and for suitability as a basis for broader discussion. All submitted papers must be previously unpublished and may not be considered for publication elsewhere at any time during I3E's review period.

The proceedings of the conference will be published by *Springer* within the IFIP Advances in Information and Communication Technology (AICT) book series. The IFIP AICT series is registered with both SCOPUS and ISI Web of Science. The paper should be no longer than 12 pages and prepared according to the guidelines of the IFIP AICT series. Submissions which deviate from the AICT guidelines may be rejected without review. Authors of all accepted papers are required to send a signed copyright form as required by The International Federation for Information Processing.
